Following documents in German or English certified translation are to be enclosed:

- 1. Recommendation of the responsible bishop or ecclesiastical superior**
- 2. Reference of the rector of the seminary, the academy or theological faculty**
- 3. Final school certificate towards further university and higher learning studies**
- 4. Certificate of final theological qualification (e.g. diploma) with details like number of weekly hours per subject, credit points, marks and certificates of successful attendance at a seminar**
- 5. Proof of knowledge of the German language (see point 4 - German language course) or confirmation of participation in an ongoing language course**
- 6. Curriculum Vitae (CV) with a photograph of the student**
- 7. Two passport photos**
- 8. Photocopy of a valid passport**
- 9. Health certificate**
- 10. Declaration** of consent to the eastern, interritual and international as well as ecumenically open conception of the seminary Collegium Orientale of the diocese of Eichstätt (an express reply by e-mail to the Rectorate of the Collegium Orientale, see separate attachment).
- 11. Personal motivation letter from the candidate stating:** a) Why would he like to study in Eichstätt in Germany? b) From whom did he learn about the study opportunity in Eichstätt. c) Where are his interests in theological science? d) What personal goals should be achieved during the study at the Faculty of Theology and in our international, interkonfessional and interritual seminary? e) What goals does the candidate have after studying in Eichstätt? - How and in what area does the candidate want to work in his church later on when he returns home and to his eparchy?

12. Application form for studies at the Catholic University of Eichstätt (KU)
13. Registration form for the language course at the Language Center of the KU
14. Copy of the application form towards a scholarship

II. Registration deadline

For the upcoming academic year the **31st of January** is the last registration date.

III. Language course

Good knowledge of German is a prerequisite.

- a) In any case, the candidate has to prove good knowledge of German (successful completion of a language course). In order to participate in a language course of the KU, good knowledge of German (A2) must be demonstrated by a corresponding document and urgently required to pass the entrance examination. This is absolutely necessary to get through the entrance examination for the language course at KU which will take – according to one's progress – one or two semester; this course will not be supported by the relief organizations and therefore has to be financed separately. Within one year, the candidate has to complete the German test successfully in order to get the scholarship and to stay at CO.
- b) On presentation of a German language certificate (e.g. TestDaF [see www.testdaf.de] or equivalent test accepted by KU), the candidate is able to begin immediately with his theological studies at KU. This certificate is necessary to get the scholarship and to stay at CO.
